We are excited to enter a new year and a new semester of offering you research support, a cozy place to study, as well as academic and personalized resources to help you make this semester your most successful one yet!

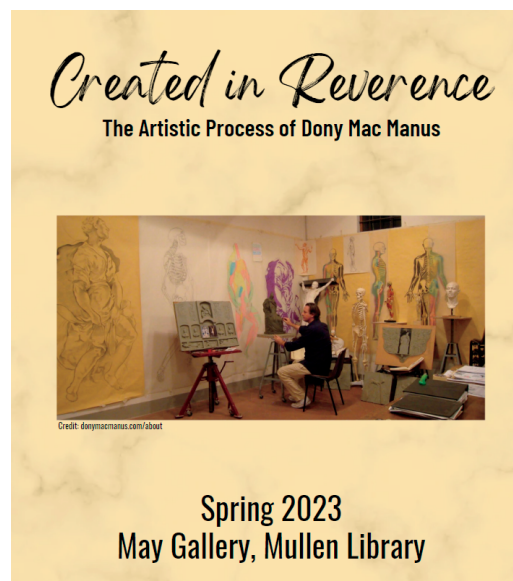
A Fresh Start: It's never too late to take advantage of the many resources that the library offers! The easiest way to get started is by taking some time to explore the library's website (libraries.catholic.edu). By navigating to the "Information for Users" section located under the "Services" tab you can choose the group that applies to you (Undergraduate Students, Graduate Students, etc.). You will then receive a list of links to different resources that are likely to be helpful to you. If you need more direct guidance, be sure to stop by the Information Desk located in the lobby of the library or call us at the number below!

My Library Account: When using the library's website, be sure to log in to your library account by clicking on "My Library Account" in the top right corner of the library website and use your Catholic U credentials. By logging into your account you can keep track of any book loans, requests, fees, and messages from the library. When searching for articles and books, you are also able to see all of your options for viewing or checking materials out including online options, the location in Mullen Library, and options for Consortium Loan Service and Interlibrary Loan whether you are on campus or off.

Need a Tutorial?: If you are having trouble navigating our resources, we have a few online tutorials to help you get oriented. These tutorials can be found in the "Online Tutorials" pages under the "Research Help" tab. Tutorials walk you through common library actions such as finding a book in the library stacks.
