Using the Library's Research Guides

Our librarians work to compile research assistance, subject lists, and useful resources into subject specific research guides. They are a great way to start your research and offer subject specific databases to check out. These guides can be found by navigating to libraries.catholic.edu, hovering over the "Research Help" tab, and clicking on "Research Guides."

Online Library Resources

You can find online articles and books you need to finish research papers and study for exams 24/7 by going to libraries.catholic.edu and typing keywords or titles into SearchBox. Find the 'Availability' filter on the left side of your results and choose 'Available Online.'

Citation Management

Use the resources below when creating your reference lists and making sure you have properly applied your professor's chosen citation style:

- For items found in the University Libraries SearchBox, choose "Citation" in the record to copy the source citation to the clipboard and then paste it into your paper's reference list.
- Save all your sources in RefWorks.
- Visit the Writing Center's website for handouts on all of the major citation styles.

Last Minute Study Tips

- Even if you need to cram for an exam, try to schedule out your studying and save some time to relax and decompress.
- Make sure to get your sleep! Sleep deprivation can hinder your focus and thought processing.
- Cut out distractions! Choose a study space for optimal focus. Don't forget to silence your phone!
