- 1. Information Desk**
SearchBox research How-To
Ask a Reference Specialist at the Information Desk for directions to the Computer Lab. Log in to the CIA University Libraries site & use SearchBox to find an item held at Mullen Library. Take a selfie with the item & keep it!
- 2. Instruction Room**
Take a selfie with the Instruction & Engagement Work Library Instruction Classes will meet here! You may use the computers and printers in this room when it is not in use for Library Instruction Classes.
- 3. Self-Checkout Station**
You may check books out to yourself at the Self-Checkout Station! Take a selfie at the Self-Checkout with the item you found in Step 1.
- 4. Popular Reading**
Our Popular Reading shelf is a great place to browse for study-break reading. Take a pic of yourself with your favorite pick on the shelf!
- 5. Group Study Spaces**
Take a selfie in one of Mullen's 4 Group Study spaces where you may talk quietly while studying in a comfy chair. Bonus Prize: If you take a selfie with the Pope's chair!
- 6. Math & Tutoring Center**
Math Center tutors will help formulate a solution to your complex equations! Solve your selfie problem by going through the Main Reading Room & adding the green room pic!
- 7. The Writing Center**
