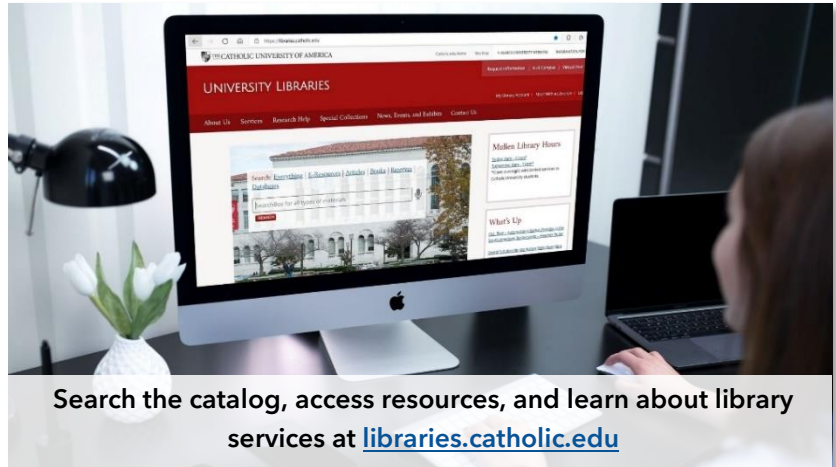
The end of the Fall semester is already approaching, and we are here to help! These library services and resources can help you finish the semester strong.

### *Consortium Loan Service (CLS)*

Did you know that CUA patrons can borrow books from partner libraries in the D.C. area? The University Libraries is part of the Washington Research Library Consortium (WRLC) which allows patrons to borrow books from nine other local universities. CLS requests can be placed through the library catalog. CLS resources will be delivered to Mullen Library for pickup within 48 hours. ### *Interlibrary Loan (ILL)*

If a resource is not available at Mullen or through CLS, consider using Interlibrary Loan. ILL can help you find books and articles from around the world! ILL requests can be submitted through your library account.
